

Pacific Lutheran High School Academic and Assessment Highlights

Class of 2011

- 100% university acceptance rate for those students submitting applications to four-year universities.
- Universities accepting students for the 2011-2012 academic year include: UCLA, California State Universities (Long Beach, Dominguez Hills), Concordia University, Master's College, Southern California College, University of North Carolina, U.C. Davis, Arizona State

Class of 2012

- Mean scores increased in 9 out of 12 subject areas on the Iowa Test of Educational Development (ITED).
- Reading Comprehension scores increased 11 percentile points from 2010-2011

Class of 2013

- Mean scores increased in 12 out of 12 subject areas on the Iowa Test of Educational Development (ITED) from the previous year's administration.
- Double-digit percentile growth occurred in 11 of 12 academic areas on the ITED.
- 12 out of 12 students' subject scores were higher than the national average.

Class of 2014

- 83% of students' composite score (average of all 12 subject-matter tests) rose from the previous year's administration of the ITED.
- 11 out of 12 student subject scores were higher than the national average.

Class of 2015

- 12 out of 12 subject scores were higher than the national average.
- Composite Score (average of all 12 subject matter tests) is 57th percentile.

Other Academic Items

- 2011-2012 Student / Teacher Ratio is 10-1.
- Average PLHS class size is 15 students
- 2010-2011 Mandatory Homework Policy Results
 - PLHS students averaged 2.1 incomplete/missing homework assignments for the entire academic year. (61% of PLHS students had 1 or less incomplete / missing homework assignments for the entire year.)
