Senior Students/Parents

Your student has expressed an interest in attending a Senior Cruise on Carnival Cruise lines with us this year. This year's trip will be February 17th-February 20th. Your child will miss half a day of school on Friday, and no school on Monday due to the President's Day Holiday.

The Senior Trip is an opportunity for the Seniors to spend significant time together, see God's amazing creation, eat too much food, and relax a bit during their Senior year. If your child will be attending this trip they will need either a certified / original birth certificate, Passport or a Passport Card to be eligible to return to the U.S.

The cruise consists of two full days at sea and a half-day for students to spend in Ensenada, Mexico. Students are not required to disembark in Mexico if they don't desire to do so. This trip will be chaperoned by teachers and parent chaperones and will cost \$400.00. This cost includes all meals, tips, gratuities, eligibility for ship events, etc. It does not include a soft-drink card (bought on ship for around \$20.00) or any additional items your student may wish to purchase. Students will need to give the Purser's Desk a \$100.00 deposit (credit card or cash) for possible ship purchases once they are on board. This is refunded at the end of the trip if no additional ship expenses have occurred.

Please return the perforated slip below with a non-refundable \$100.00 payment to the school by Friday, November 18th if your child will be attending this year's senior cruise. Full payment for the cruise is due Monday, December 12th.
